COMPOSITION COMMENTS: A petroleum distillate blend.

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION:

Flammable. Toxic to aquatic organisms, may cause long-term adverse effects in the aquatic environment. Harmful: may cause lung damage if swallowed. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES:

INHALATION: Move the exposed person to fresh air at once. For breathing difficulties oxygen may be necessary. If breathing stops, provide artificial respiration. Keep the affected person warm and

at rest. Get prompt medical attention.

INGESTION:

Do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, the head should be kept low so that stomach vomit doesn't enter the lungs. Remove victim immediately from source of exposure. Provide rest, warmth and fresh air. Get medical attention immediately!

SKIN:

Remove affected person from source of contamination. Remove contaminated clothing. Wash the skin immediately with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists after washing.

EYES:

Make sure to remove any contact lenses from the eyes before rinsing. Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Contact physician if irritation persists.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES:**EXTINGUISHING MEDIA:**

Fire can be extinguished using: Carbon dioxide (CO2). Foam. Dry chemicals, sand, dolomite etc.

SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURES:

Avoid breathing fire vapours. Cool containers exposed to flames with water until well after the fire is out. Keep run-off water out of sewers and water sources. Dike for water control.

Flammable/combustible - Keep away from oxidizers, heat and flames. Keep in cool, dry, ventilated storage and closed containers. Keep in original container. Protect against physical damage and/or friction. May attack some plastics, rubber and coatings.
